*\* Provided your household made more than \$32,000 in 2008, you should have some state tax liability. Look at your 2008 taxes to find out how much you paid in taxes to the State of Arizona. If you make a contribution of that size (up to a maximum of \$500 for a single filer or \$1,000 for a married couple filing jointly), you should receive it back in your tax refund come tax time. As AWSF may not provide tax advice, check with your tax advisor to be certain.*
